SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES FOR THE ARNOLD "BUD" COLIN SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship is for \$1,000 a year for four years for a maximum of \$4,000. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance for students attending college for four years.

Students must complete a **Scholarship and Award Application** form in order to be considered for the scholarship. Evidence of college enrollment, attendance, acceptable academic performance and a letter describing the student's goals and progress must be submitted each year to the Guidance Office in order to receive scholarship funds. If a student is unable to complete four years, the scholarship ends with the last year of college the student completed.

The decision to award the scholarship and subsequent funding will be made by the Scholarship Committee of Highlands High School. Awardees must live in Harrison Township, PA.

A copy of the SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES will be given to all successful awardees.
