What are WIN Groups?

Referred to as "WIN" by students and teachers, we provide a "What I Need" time block. The goal of the WIN block is to provide our students with what they need based on skill level, in order to help them reach their academic potential.

Currently, we are working on the following skills, which all can be simply taught by just speaking with your child. They are taught in the following order:

Clapping out words in a 3, 4, 5-word sentence.

Recognize what words do and don't rhyme.

Produce a rhyming word.

Recognize the first sounds in words.

Verbally break 3 letter words down into sounds.

Verbally blend sounds to make 3-letter words.

Other Skills that require materials/flash cards:

Recognizing Letter Names

Recognizing Letter Sounds

Recognizing Sight Words

Making 3-letter words.
