



Bite Into Books

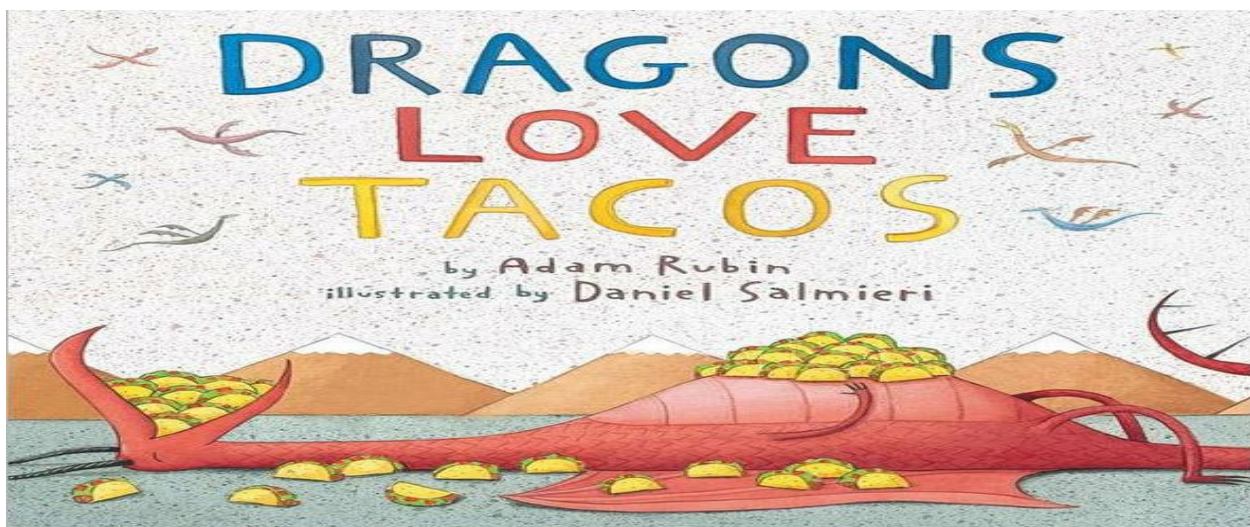
Dear Parents of Highlands Elementary School Second Grade Students,
