The activities must make a tic-tactoe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. Write each spelling word in a rainbow of colors. First, write the words with a red crayon. Trace over the words with a blue crayon. Finally, trace the words again with a green crayon.	Write each spelling word. Highlight the vowel pattern in each word (aa or aw) or write the vowel pattern in a different color.	Use ALL of your spelling words to write a short story. Your story must include all of your spelling words
. Make a set of flashcards for studying your words.	Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.	Write a song or a rap using all of your spelling words
Write your spelling words in spooky looking letters. Ex.	Print each word. Next to it, write the word in dots.	Use a dictionary to write a definition for each word. (You can borrow a dictionary from school if you do not have one at home.)
