Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe

This board includes many different activities to help your child practice his/her spelling words. Your child must choose at least **three** of the activities to complete for weekly homework. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three in a row. <p>Rhyming Words– Write each of your spelling words. Next to each word, write a rhyming word. If necessary, your rhyming words can be nonsense words, but make them follow the same spelling pattern.</p>	<p>Play a game to practice your spelling words at www.spellingcity.com. Click "Find a list" at the top of the page. Select "Search by teacher name" and enter <i>lakewood</i>. Click "search." Click on the lesson and grade of your choice. Click on any of the game options available.</p>	<p>Take a practice test at home given by a parent. Write any missed word 3 times each.</p>
<p>Blue Vowels– Write each of your spelling words. Using a blue colored pencil, trace over the vowels in each word. Remember the vowels are: a e i o u</p>	<p>Spelling Worksheet</p>	<p>Words Without Vowels– Write your spelling words on a list, but replace all the vowels with a line. Then go back to the beginning of your list and see if you can fill in the correct missing vowels.</p>
<p>Make and complete a word search using www.puzzlemaker.com</p>	<p>Other Handed– If you are right handed, write your spelling words using your left hand. If you are left handed, write your spelling words using your right hand.</p>	<p>"Pyramid Write" your spelling words. You must write neatly! Example: h he hea hear</p>
