Highlands School District's 2015-2016 budget totals \$42,964,481, a 3.1% increase over the prior year. The budget maintains all current programs with NO TAX INCREASE. The budget includes 3 additional educational positions for English, HVA and Reading, and a School Resource Officer at Grandview. The budget also includes \$60,000 for Elementary Reading supplies, High School Science and Social Studies textbooks, and \$80,000 for additional technology support.
