Remote Learning Start Dates

The remote learning schedule for all students will begin the week of March 30, 2020.

Guidelines for Students Engaged in Remote Learning

Each day, students should do the following:

- Check-in for attendance Daily attendance will be taken via a GoogleDoc by the classroom teacher
- Each teacher will communicate an instructional plan using one of above listed resources
- Daily structure of activities and/or assignments:
 - O Students in grades K-2: 4 lessons a day approximately 20-30 minutes each
 - o Students in grades 3-6: 1 lesson per subject per day approximately 30-40 minutes each
 - o Students in grades 7-12: approximately three hours a day total
- Beginning on Monday, March 30, teachers will be available via email in the event that students or parents have questions.
- Nurses and School Counselors will be available during the school day via email for support.

Special Area classes (Art, Music, FACS, World Language, Foundations, Innovation, Forum, Tech Ed, BCIT and Physical Education)

• Activities/lessons will be posted weekly for students to complete

Access to Alternative Assignments

Alternative assignments will be provided in hard copy for any student who lacks accessibility or connectivity. A distribution plan to get materials to students is in development and will be communicated to families in the following days. If a family did not respond to the technology survey or telephone messages from the District, it will be assumed that your family has access to these resources.
