- 3. Purchase of elementary component for Highlands Virtual Academy (HVA) to have a full-week remote K-12 option
- 4. HVA as the full-week remote learning option / 9-week commitment
- 5. Parent Survey review
 - a. Highlights: Approximately 75% in favor of split (hybrid) week

 Majority prefer teacher-led learning for remote days

 Approximately 41% able to provide transportation
- 6. Special School Board Meeting in July to approve Health & Safety Plan; gives parents time to arrange child care
- 7. Task Force Vote on Reopening Plan
 - a. Hybrid schedule with synchronous learning
 - i. Group A M/T in school and W/Th remote
 - ii. Group B M/T remote and W/Th in school
 - iii. Everyone Remote on Friday
 - iv. Deep cleaning Tuesday evening, Friday & Saturday
 - v. Schedule siblings in the same group (if parents prefer)
- 8. Discussion of Special Education student needs
- 9. Decide date for parent decision (hybrid or HVA)
- 10. Cameras in classrooms for synchronous learning and remote student participation
- 11. Grading (not pass/fail)
