4. Make sure that you check that Forbes Road CTC is on your next year's schedule.

What grade do I need to be in to attend Forbes Road CTC?

Students can start attending Forbes Road CTC as a ninth grader in our Exploratory Program. All sending district students in grades 10—12 are eligible to participate in Vocational Training as part of the PDE School Code.

How much does it Cost?

There is no tuition cost for you to attend Forbes Road CTC. The sending districts compensate Forbes. The only cost to you maybe uniform, kit and/or tool costs.

Can I Still Join Sports at my Home School?

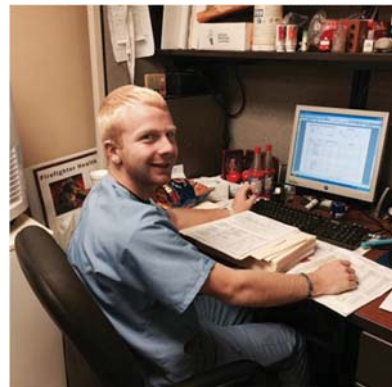

APPRENTICESHIP - Students begin paid work-site learning as youth apprentices during their junior and/or senior years of high school. Students spend two days at a work-site under the supervision of a work-site mentor.

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION—This method of instruction integrates academic and technical education with job training in the student’s career field through written co-operative arrangements between the schools, employers, parents and students.

INTERNSHIP—Through actual work experience, the non-paid Internship program is designed to give students the “work experience” often demanded by today’s employers. This program provides support, guidance, evaluation, and allows the student to utilize the skills gained in the classroom.



JOB SHADOWING—Students spend time at a work-site to gain insight and information about their chosen career fields. 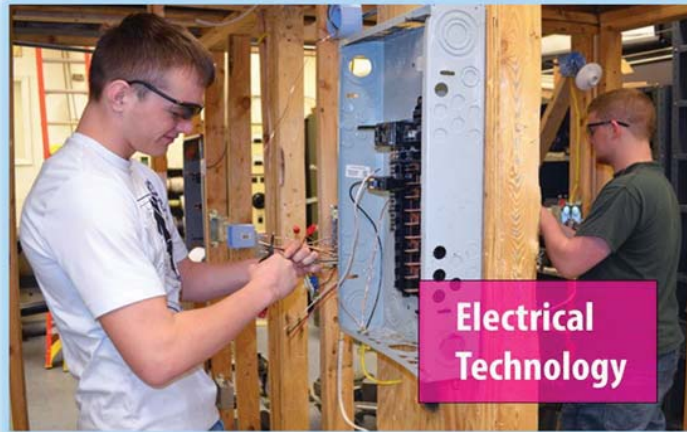

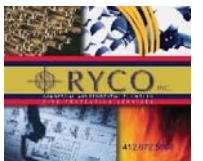
