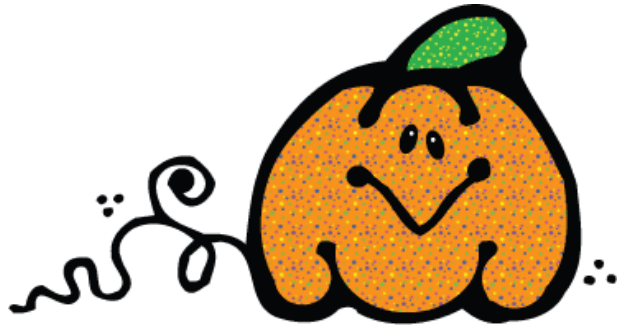


Pinwheels for Peace
