What is Comprehension?

Comprehension is the understanding and interpretation of what is read. To be able to accurately understand written material, children need to be able to:

1. Decode what they read
2. Make connections between what they read and what they already know
3. Think deeply about what they have read.

- Why do you think...

During Reading:

- I wonder why...
- What do you think about...
- This reminds me of...

After Reading:

- What would have happened with...
- I wonder why the author...
- What message is the author telling you?
